

Race Information:

All fees in Canadian funds please.

Friday: 6.30-8.00 pm - Registration open for all classes
8.00 pm - Bib draw (performed by organising committee, driver need not attend)
Saturday: 7.15 am - Late Registration open for all classes.
7.45 am - Registration closed for all classes

Bib Draw Rules: Friday night's registrations will be drawn and placed into NRB/Purebred and Open categories based on draw numbers or seeding.

Saturday morning's entries will be placed at the discretion of the race marshal.

Note: Any pre-registration received **with payment** prior to Thursday evening will be included in the Friday night bib draws.

Mandatory Drivers' Meeting: For all classes is Saturday 7.45 am and Sunday (excluding rookie/Saturday only classes) 7.30 am at the Visitors Centre. (**Drivers only, no handlers**).

Any driver not in attendance may be given a monetary/time penalty or disqualified from race at the race marshal's discretion.

Registered Northern Breed: Please have your purebred registration papers on hand and fill out our RNB race sheet supplied on the race information page. Accepted breed registration associations: CKC (Canadian Kennel Club), UKC (United Kennel Club), AKC (American Kennel Club), FCI (Federation Cynologique Internationale) or KC (United Kingdom Kennel Club).

Top 3 placing purebred teams may be asked for proof of breed registration. Dogs of the acknowledged sled dog breeds include: Siberian Husky, Alaskan Malamute, Samoyed, Greenland Dog or Inuit Dog.

Friday Afternoon: Trail Access: A Park's Ontario guest day pass will be required to enter park on Friday before 5.00 pm, unless you are part of the rustic camping group. Trails will be under race construction over the course of the day in preparation for races.

If you visit the race areas on Friday afternoon, please park at back of parking lot, away from chute/start/finish to allow for crews to work without obstructions.

Parking Lots: Friday night - No personal items or equipment shall be left in the mushers or visitors parking lot. This is at the request of the park.

You cannot hold a parking spot overnight on Friday for Saturday morning, it is first come, first served parking on Saturday morning.

Vehicles with trailers 5ft long or larger, please park on the right side of the parking lot. Other vehicles and trailers under 4ft long park on the left side of the parking lot.

Park opens for mushers at 6.30 am Saturday and Sunday - No park fees for mushers on Saturday/Sunday.

Sunday: Mushers are asked to park in the same place as they did on Saturday to avoid kennel cross-contamination.
